

Area Winter Camp Unit Gear List

- Tent/s (Large tents are not ideal for winter camping unless you can fully fill them, the more girls in any tent will keep the tent warmer.).
- Extra tent poles, various types of pegs/spikes, rope
- Tarps & blankets
- Extra clothing, mitts and hats for “cold” girls
- Whistle
- Watch or clock
- Safe Guide forms Girls' and Guiders' Health forms (must be paper H.1 forms, no internet to access e-pact), additional Health forms.
- Camp tools - mallet for tent pegs, snow shovel to dig tent spot
- Firewood (asking each unit to bring 1 bundle of firewood)
- Matches, lighter, newspaper (for starting stove & a fire)
- Duct tape
- Camp stove with extra fuel
- Lantern with extra batteries
- Rubbermaid bin containing Cooking utensils & cookware: pots (1 large & 1 medium), fry pan, can opener, knives, spoons, spatula, ladel, mixing bowls, kettle, pot holder, cutting boards, baking soda (in case of grease fires), tin foil, paper towels, kitchen towel, wipes, non-stick cooking spray or oil, tablecloths, napkins, rubber gloves, garbage bags, food handling gloves, Ziploc bags, rope for clothes line & clothes pins
- Pieces of old carpet to put under vehicle tires, for better traction after vehicles have been parked for a few days. Pack some sand and salt too, in case parking lot is icy.
- Pop up tent/shelter (please let the camping committee know if you do not have one)
- 6ft folding table (please let the camping committee know if you do not have one)

Please make sure your kitchen items are labelled as we will have one indoor washing station for all units.
