**COST:** \$116 + HST (for a total of \$131.08)

Optional Take Home Manual \$15+HST (total of \$16.95)

Comprehensive course offering first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) skills for those who need training due to work requirements or who want more knowledge to respond to emergencies at home. Course meets legislation requirements for provincial/territorial worker safety and insurance boards and includes the latest first aid and CPR guidelines. Exceeds Pathfinder Canada Cord requirements. Useful for those applying for jobs in the Parks and Recreation Field, wishing to be a Lifeguard, Camp Councillor, or any other job where youth is involved.

A Blended Course, means you complete the theory of First Aid online and then come in for 1 full day of skills. Once registered and paid you will receive an invitation from the Red Cross Training Portal to commence the online portion of the course. This consists of quizzes, games, and videos to help you learn the theory behind first aid. On your skills day you will be doing all the hand son practical skills.

## Standard First Aid and CPR/AED Level C Recertification Course

**COST:** \$99 + HST (for a total of \$111.87)

Optional Take Home Manual \$15+HST (total of \$16.95)

Comprehensive recertification course for those with a Current Standard First Aid and CPR/AED. This course will keep you current for another 3 years.

Please note to qualify you must meet the following criteria, and you will be required to provide proof of current certification:

- 1) That the chosen course is before your current card expiry date
- 2) That the last course you took was a full Standard First Aid course, not a recertification (your certification card says "Is Certified In", not "Is recertified in".
- 3) That your current certificate was provided by the Canadian Red Cross

Course meets legislation requirements for provincial/territorial worker safety and insurance boards and includes the latest first aid and CPR guidelines.

### **COURSE REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE CERTIFICATION (both courses):**

- Attendance: You must attend 100% of the course to be certified
- **Skills:** The Canadian Red Cross has a Standards in the form of a Skills Checklist, participant must competently demonstrate each skill on the check list. Should you wish to know the skill requirements ahead of time, please email us at info@durhamfirstaid.com.
- Written evaluation: There is a written component at the end of the course which is multiple-choice. If you have any test writing anxiety, learning disabilities, language difficulties, or if you require extra time or a private space to write, we can accommodate you. Please just make sure you let us know. If you have any questions or concerns about the test, please do not hesitate to call or email or speak to your instructor at the beginning of the course.

### **Cancelation Policy**

- If you do not show up your course (you are a **NO SHOW**), without notice before the start of the course (i.e., 9am) no refund will be provided (this includes if you are feeling unwell due to COVID and do not give us notice before the start time for your class).
- Rescheduling will not be accommodated if you have not provided notice before the course start time.
- Refunds are not provided if you have missed or rescheduled <u>from your original course/booked</u> date.
- If you are unable to attend your prearranged chosen course or course date, we will gladly switch you 1 time free of charge to another course at a date and time that is convenient for you. This request must be made at least 24 hours before the start of your course date and time. Should you need to switch additional times, or your request is made within 24 hours of the start of the course a \$20 administration fee will be charged. Once the course has started, if you have not provided notice that you were not attending, no rescheduling will be permitted. Again, once you switch from your original course date, no refunds will be provided.
- If you have not yet paid for the course (i.e. we are invoicing your company), or it was discussed that you will pay by cash or debit the day of the course, and you do not show, you or your company will be invoiced for the cost of the course, at the agreed upon rate at registration.
- Should you need to cancel your registration, the following will apply:
  - A refund will be issued if your request to withdraw from a course is made 3 or more business days prior to the start of the course (i.e. Tuesday for a Saturday course, Thursday for a Wednesday Course).
  - A refund equal to 50% of the course fee will be issued if a request to withdraw from a course is made less than 3 business days prior to the start of the course. <u>Again, this</u> <u>does not apply if you have already rescheduled or did not attend your original course</u> date.
  - No refunds will be issued for those wishing to withdraw once the course has started.
     Rescheduling is also not permitted once the course has started.
  - o If materials have been obtained in advance of the course, all materials must be returned in re-saleable condition before the refund is issued.
- Should there be quarantine restrictions implemented by the government, no refunds will be issued, and your course fee will be held until we can return to the classroom.
- If Durham First Aid Inc. needs to cancel a course for unforeseen circumstances (i.e., insufficient numbers to run the course), we will:
  - Attempt to transfer the participant into an alternate course date, at no additional cost to the participant.
  - Issue a full refund if no alternate course date is available that fits the participant's
