This is a quick snapshot of what you need to bring for the Cardboard Fun Event on January 18. The activity will be a creative competition with multiple categories for creating of different cardboard creations.

Please share the SG.1 with your parents so they know the details of the event. Add in your contact information at the bottom before sending.

You need Green Ratio - 1 Adult to every 15 youth members with a minimum of 2 Guiders for Guide Groups, 1 Guider for Pathfinders and Above.

Cost covers materials, a snack and a crest. You will be charged based on your final number at the event after the event.

We ask that Guiders Bring the following

- Empty rubbermaid bin(s) or large box to collect your unit's jackets at the event. We will tuck these out of the way but this helps us keep the space clean and organized in the midst of chaos.
- Copies of H.1 and H.2 health forms for your unit.
- Indoor shoes and a water bottle for yourself
- A couple extra snacks just in case.
- Your unit Scissors, Glue (white or hot glue guns) and markers - we will not have enough for all members, please make sure you bring some just in case.
- **The filled out Unit List with everyone, adult and youth member, on that list, printed out to hand in at sign in.**
- Guiders should know who in their group doesn't have a signed Image Release - we will ask before taking photos.
