Catalogue of Sessions for January Thaw 2025

Bits and Bites - Come taste camp goodies. There will be a small cost (\$3-5) to help cover the cost of the food provided.

Buzzer Games - BUZZ! Challenge your youth to play within a specific time limit! Learn some quick activities that you can apply a loud buzzer to!

Safe Guide - need to take a quick refresher - this is for you!

SWAPS - SWAPS stands for "Special Whatchamacallits Affectionately Pinned Somewhere." They are small tokens of friendship that youth exchange with one another, and each SWAP uniquely reflects a fellow Girl Guide, their unit, or a memory of a special event. In this session participants create several unique, outrageous, interactive and useful SWAPS to take back to their units.

10 Minute Activities - Come explore some activities that take only small snatches of time - perfect when you are transitioning from one big thing to another! Get the wriggles out with 10-minute (backpocket) games.

Drop-in Coffee Chat - Come and chat with DEIA facilitators and get answers to those questions.

General Fiber Arts - What to do with all that wool!

Gumball Machines - let's see what we can do with gumball (gacha) machines; what sort of surprises could be in store?

Active Songs - join in as we sing some songs with active movement - perfect for shaking the sillies off!

Leather Crafts - a simple punch or two and you are on your way to a leather masterpiece! Join in this session and see what can be done with leather! (A small supply fee will be requested. Please bring along some money)

Sticking Around - Sparks and Embers going on walks get elevated to Branch Managers with the right tools! Discover some activities you can do with sticks, on hikes.

Ukulele 1 - An introductory course to ukulele - after you are done, you can stick around for part 2!

Game of Life - Skills

In this session participants will be guided through a unique game of life where you will learn a variety of life skills. This session will provide guiders with a fun interactive program game that will have youth learning basic life skills such as cooking, money, etiquette and more.
