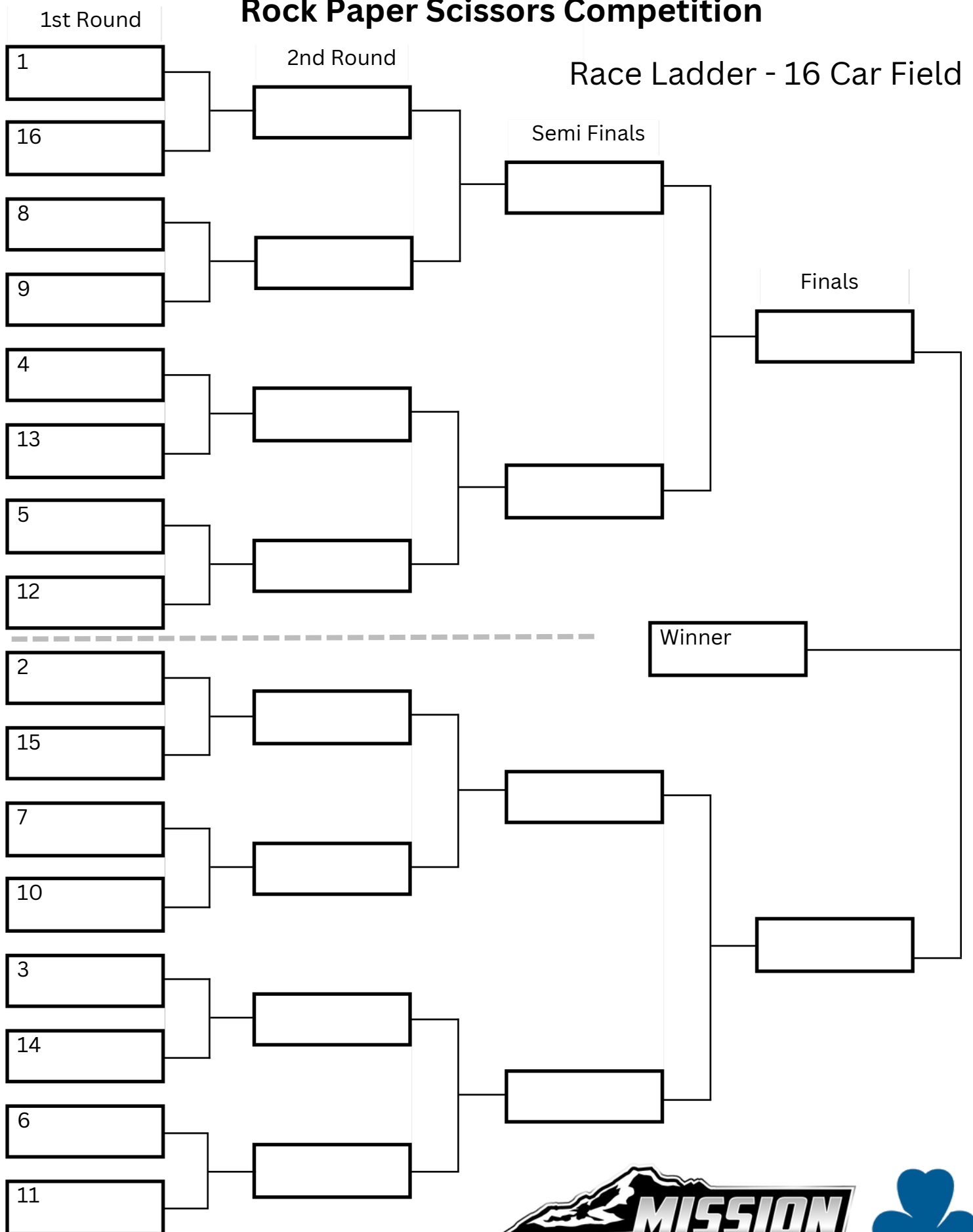

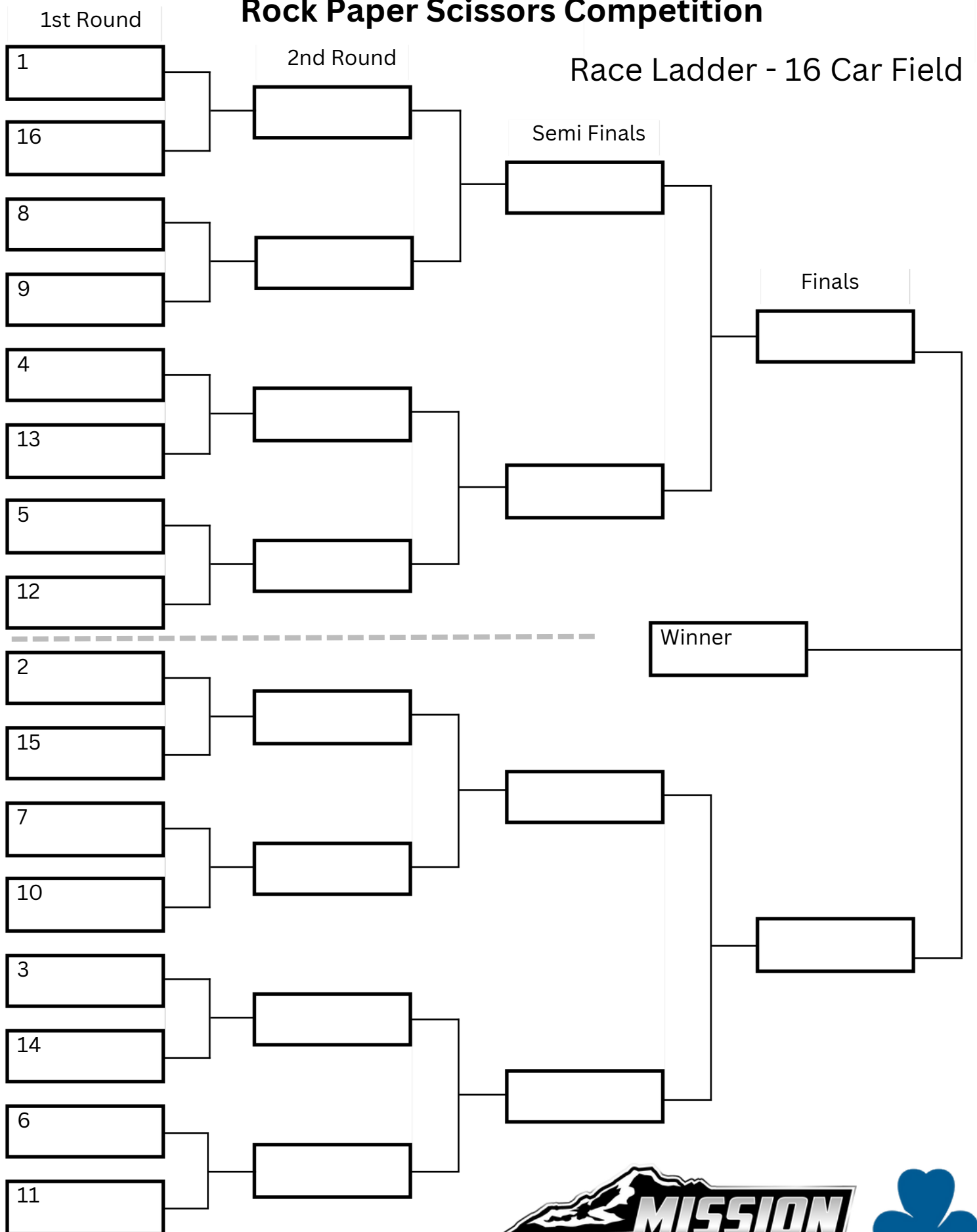

Sally Racer - Race Weekend Budget

Sally and her family of 3 attend Mission Raceway Park for a weekend race in June. They arrive Thursday Evening and camp for the weekend (from Thursday after dinner to Sunday after dinner). Sally attends Test & Tune on Friday, Race #1 on Saturday and Race #2 on Sunday.

Sally and her family eat one meal per day at the track concession stand and pack the rest of their food and drinks to prepare at their pit spot.

How much should Sally and her family budget for the race weekend?

Camping Fees: \$30 per weekend

Race Entry Fees: \$40 per race

Test & Tune Entry Fees: \$40

Average Fuel Cost Per Race Day \$15

Average Cost of Fuel to Get To and From the Race Track \$20

Concession Meals cost approx \$15 (*per person*)

Camping Meals cost approx \$25 (*for the whole family*)



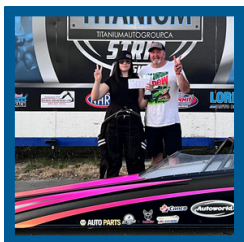
