Monashee Area Girl Guides invite you to embark on an exciting overnight trek like no other!

Nite Trek 2025 is a thrilling challenge designed for Girl Guides and Scouts, where teams will navigate 8-10 km of cross-country ski trails at Telemark Trails—under the cover of night!

Along the way, groups will encounter **Jurassic-themed challenge stations**, where teamwork will be essential to complete tasks. To keep the adventure going, a **Hot Chocolate and Hotdog Station** will be set up halfway through the trek for a warm and well-deserved break.

This is your chance to test your skills, build friendships, and create lasting memories in a unique outdoor setting. Get ready for a night of adventure, teamwork, and fun!

Who: Scouts & Venturers, Guides, Pathfinders, Rangers Trex, Trekking groups will be organized into groups of 4-6 with both girls and boys of the same age range to Trek

When: Saturday, May 10th, 12:00 pm - Sunday, May 11th, 9:30 am Check in - Once everyone in your patrol/troop has arrived please check in before 2:00 pm.

Cost: \$40.00 per youth

The cost of the event includes a crest, dinner on Saturday night, and the Nite Trek experience. GST is included per registered youth.

Where: Telemark Trails by Crystal Mountain.

Telemark Trails is located on a paved road in West Kelowna, 9 km up Glenrosa Road. Go west (up) Glenrosa Road interchange on Highway 97 towards Crystal Mountain. The Telemark parking lot is 3 km before Crystal Mountain. There is a large Telemark sign at the entrance to the parking lot.

Patrol/Troop Information:

Each Patrol/Troop will bring their camping equipment, food, and snacks for all meals except Saturday night dinner. All participants must bring suitable clothing and footwear for an early spring event – a kit list will be provided when registration closes. Be prepared it may be cold and the trail will be wet in some areas.

Registration: The information you need to register your unit

Each Unit/Troop is required to provide 3 Adults and have at least the 7:1 ratio covered. If you have a group larger than 21, please bring an extra Guider.

- 1 will stay at base camp until all Trekkers have returned.
- 1 is needed to help at stations
- 1 is needed for security to walk the trail.

To register through the Double Knot system, please have the following information ready:

- Youth's name
- Detailed explanation of any food-related allergies, including severity
- **Preferred buddy** (ensure your youth is paired with a friend from their patrol/troop)

Parent Helper needs the following to volunteer

GGC - A7 approved Scouts - Parent Overnight Helpers approved

Health forms

GGC - H1 or Epact form Scouts - Health form Adults – H2

Each youth must carry their form during the event or hike, with an additional copy kept at their site/base camp. Adults are also required to carry a health form with them for the duration of the event.
