The Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada directive on uniform states that it is up to the Individual girl with her parent(s) to decide which uniform options best suit her needs. AGP, however, is a formal event, not casual like a camp. The official Formal Uniform of your organization is worn for our trip to the Legislature, official photograph, the Opening Ceremony and AGP Banquet. You will be meeting invited Keynote Speakers where the official uniform will be worn.

DRESS UNIFORM/BUSINESS DRESS OPTIONS:

- Official GGC Uniform Shirt for Rangers or Pathfinders
 - GGC tie and appropriate insignia (including Canada Cord)
 - dark bottoms – pants or skirt, either navy or black (no jeans)
 - shoes – dark-coloured, close-toed e.g. pumps, flats, runners (please no sandals, boots or white shoes)
 - neutral hosiery if wearing a skirt
- Optional:*
- Plain, white long-sleeve blouse with collar & GGC scarf, if applicable
 - Sweater, blazer, cardigan or hoodie (no logos, unless GGC), in solid navy, black or white
 - White, solid navy or black dress

Please borrow *extra* pieces of uniform so that you have changes, there is not laundry facilities available. You will be wearing your uniform for the better part of each day. It is a common practice among Guiders and girls who attend events to borrow extra uniform pieces from others in the Guiding community. Older style uniforms are acceptable.

CASUAL WEAR:

There are occasions when you may wear more casual clothes, but they too should be appropriate to the occasion, e.g., no tank or halter tops. Suggestions for these times:

- other Guiding clothing
- jeans
- sweatpants/sweatshirts/T-shirts/shorts for *active living session* and fun activities
- comfortable shoes



OTHER ITEMS TO BRING:

- Soft shoes or slippers for indoors
- Warm outdoor clothes
- Boots or heavy shoes for outside
- Personal kit (toiletries)
- Towel (optional)
- Cell phone (optional)
- Notebook and pencil/pen
- Wristwatch
- Clock with alarm (optional)
- Flashlight
- Camera (optional)
- Fabric Scissors (to cut fleece)

SPENDING MONEY:

There is time set aside to go to West Edmonton Mall, where you might like to do a little shopping or swimming at the Waterpark.

Please note that these are extra activities and not included in the registration fee.

ACCOMMODATION:

Delegates will be sleeping in single or double rooms. Each room has a single or double bed and all bedding is provided. Showers and toilets are down the hall. Although towels are provided, you may want to bring your own towel if you are planning on going to the Waterpark.

If you are 16 years of age at the time of the event and working on this program we encourage you to use AGP as your qualifying residential event. Please bring your booklet and present it at the registration desk on arrival. We will complete our evaluation during the event and return your book on departure.
