FRIDAY REGISTRATION DETAILS

Registration runs from **5:00pm – 8:00pm Friday, April 24 at Straiton Hall, 4698 Sumas Mountain Road, Abbotsford**. You will receive a nest of goodies in your bag, including the agenda for the weekend and your activity choices for Saturday. You will find parking at the hall, registration, some light refreshments, mix n' mingle, a Campfire later in the evening. Even though there will be a few nibblies available, it is suggested that you find nourishment before driving to registration. **Registration cost for the whole weekend is \$30.**

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS

Stay at **Camp McLanlin**, GGC camp, in one of the buildings or bring your tent. There are bunks at both Marion's Manor and Robin's Roost in a dorm-type setting and priority will be given to those who request and use a top bunk. Due to limited parking available at camp, there will be a shuttle service from Straiton Hall parking lot to camp and back/forth for Banquet/Activities Staging area. **Accommodation cost is \$70** for two nights accommodation and two breakfasts. There are a limited number of bottom bunks, therefore it is first-come, first-served basis until they are full, then it is up in the boughs you go! Further "kit list" descriptions will be sent out in the registration package.

Alternate options for accommodation are to stay in one of the hotels close by, stay with a friend, bring your trailer and stay in one of the campgrounds, book Air BnB/VRBO. Directions:

Take the Whatcom Rd exit off Highway #1 and head north, turn right on McKee, left on Upper Sumas Mtn Rd. (There are streetlamps all the way to the end of McKee Rd.) Straiton Hall will be on your right.

Alternate Route

Take the Sumas Exit off Highway #1 and head north, turn right on Highway 11 (follow signs for Mission) turn right on Clayburn Rd. Bear left on Straiton Rd. (after bridge). Straiton Rd turns into Dawson Rd. Turn right on Sumas Mountain Rd. Straiton Hall will be on your left.

#2 alternate route

Heading east from Greater Vancouver - if Hwy #1 is busy, Take 264th St exit and head south on 264th. Turn left on 52th Ave, turn left on 40th Ave, which turns into Downes road (there will be a zig zag to get under the Hwy #1). Follow Downes Rd, turn left on Seldon Rd, right on Clayburn Rd. Go straight across Hwy 11 to continue on Clayburn Rd. Bear left on Straiton Road (after bridge). Straiton Rd turns into Dawson Rd. Turn right on Sumas Mountain Rd. Straiton Hall will be on your left.

SERVICE PROJECTS

We are offering 2 service projects:

Great Blue Heron Nature Reserve. Sign up for the volunteer session on Saturday! We are volunteering our time and energy to help this 325 acres of forests and wetlands reserve keep invasive plants at bay to help support a better habitat for the nesting birds. A walk along a trail to possibly view nesting Great Blue Herons will be included.

OWL Rehab. OWL is dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and release of raptors (eagles, falcons, hawks, osprey, owls, and vultures). We are offering to build Owl boxes as a session, for OWL to distribute.

SATURDAY BANQUET

Be sure to fill your gullet at Saturday's dinner! Arrival at Straiton Hall (4698 Sumas Mountain Road) is between 5:00-5:30. Dinner will be served at 6pm. Our interactive entertainment will get you strutting your stuff!

ACTIVITIES ON SATURDAY

We are offering an array of activities and a range of costs per activities. The activities are located at Camp McLanlin and various offsite locations.

There are times listed for meeting at the parking lot at Straiton Hall, 4698 Sumas Mountain Road, as well as travel time to the venue, and start time for the activity; offering choices in case you are running late.

Carpooling is expected. No vehicles are to travel to Camp McLanlin without permission from logistics person.

We are requesting volunteers to drive others to the various activities. Please mark on the registration form how many seatbelts there are in your vehicle (not including yourself). Kilometres are measured from the parking lot at Straiton Hall to the venue and back. You may choose to donate your travel mileage or fill in an expense sheet. Exceptions to this are the Brewery Tour, Libation Tour, and As The Crow Flies, where a driver will be provided.
