



**We hope you join us for some of these activities! Please read through each description to see if its right for you! **After each activity at Camp McLanlin, participants will be shuttled to the Straiton Hall parking lot to meet their group for an activity out in the community and vice versa.**

### **SARDIS PARK**

This 5-hectare (12.28 acre) park (a former gravel pit) has been part of Chilliwack's park inventory since 1971. The 655-metre outer looping trail allows the visitors to take in the wonderful views and vistas as they participate in outdoor activities.

The western painted turtle (*Chrysemys picta bellii*) is found in the Lower Fraser Valley, which includes Chilliwack. The Pacific Coast population, which is considered "Endangered", can be found in areas like the Vedder River, Cheam Lake Wetlands, and Sardis Park in Chilliwack. The easy stroll around the lake you should see many of the turtles basking in the sunshine if it is nice out.

Estimated duration is 1.5 hrs.

Max 5 participants.

## **OTHELO TUNNELS**

The Othello Tunnels are a series of five historic railway tunnels and bridges carved through granite in British Columbia's Coquihalla Canyon Provincial Park, near the town of Hope. Originally built for the Kettle Valley Railway in 1914, they are now a popular 3.5-kilometer round-trip hiking trail and part of the Trans Canada Trail system. Trefoil participants can choose how far they want to venture. Visitors can walk through the tunnels, enjoy scenic views of the Coquihalla River, and find them a family-friendly and accessible outdoor destination. The trail is considered wheelchair and stroller-friendly. Approximate walking time varies (depending upon individual's desire). Stop near Hope for a bite.

### First Pour: Fraser Valley Cidery

Begin your journey where crisp air and orchard views set the tone. Known for its small-batch, handcrafted ciders made from locally grown apples, this cidery offers a tasting experience that's both refreshing and educational. Whether you prefer dry, tart, or sweet, the variety of flavors—from classic apple to seasonal blends—will awaken your palate. Food is also available for purchase

### Berry Bliss: Krause Berry Farm

Next, head to Krause Berry Farm where you'll sip on fruit-forward wines made from berries grown on-site, including raspberry, blueberry, and strawberry varieties. The farm's Wine Tasting Room is a cozy spot to sample their award-winning pours, and don't miss the fresh-baked berry pies or the famous waffle bar for a sweet interlude.

### Final Toast: Roots and Wings Distillery

Cap off your tour at Roots and Wings Distillery, Langley's first craft distillery. This family-run gem produces small-batch vodka, gin, and whiskey using ingredients grown right on their farm. The tasting room offers a warm welcome and a chance to try inventive cocktails made with their artisan spirits. The distillery's name reflects its philosophy: rooted in tradition, with a bold spirit of innovation. Food also available for purchase


